Minutes from September 6, 2011 General Meeting

Secretary's Report:

Mary Jo Davis presented the minutes from the August 16, 2011 meeting.

A motion was made by Christine Farias to accept the minutes and seconded by Azalea Cervantes. The motion passed. Each parent was invited to join the Booster Club.

Treasurer's Report:

Julia Mather presented the treasurer's reports for September 2011.

It was noted that funds were low and fundraising efforts should begin immediately. A motion was made by Jasmine Nicholas to accept the treasurer's report and seconded by Adriana Hopf. The motions passed. Members were advised to pay remaining amounts owed. The Social Committee will be reimbursed for expenses as money is fundraised.

President's Report:

Jenny Frank thanked members for working the District Stadium concession stand, chaperoning the games, setting out bleacher pads, and bringing water for the girls.

Fundraising- Bake Sale: Members were reminded of the upcoming bake sale on Friday, September 9. Each rank is assigned items to bring by Thursday. See website for assignment. All items should be marked with girl's name. Volunteers for the bake sale should arrive by 9:30 am, the first lunch starts around 10:10 am. Butter Braid: Fundraising forms were passed out for pastries to be sold. Each girl is to sell \$80 worth or buy out for \$40. Checks are to be made to CBCBC.

Adelaide's Boutique: On Saturday, September 24, 20% of profits will be donated to the Celebrities if the buyer mentions the Celebrities. Adelaide's is located at Space Center and Pineloch. Homecoming carnival will be held on Friday, September 30 from around 11:20-1:20. Drinks and cookies donated by the girls will be sold for 1 ticket (\$1). Volunteers should arrive at 9:30. The pep rally will follow the carnival. Garage Sale/Car Wash: To be held October 15. Each girl will work and must bring a parent. Members were asked to start saving items to donate. Items must be tagged.

It was noted that the girls will march in the Homecoming Parade on Wednesday, September 28. The parade takes place on Hope Village Rd. around 6:00 pm. The road will be blocked off around 5:30.

Publicity:

Kelly Boerke reported that the Spirit Girl and Celebrity of the Week should be added to the Football program. She also reminded members to seek corporate sponsors. We may also get a day at Potbelly's sandwich shop where they will donate 25% of profits to Celebrities on a particular day. She is seeking the date for that fundraiser.

1st Vice President's Report:

Members were advised of a fundraising possibility of working the concession stand at the Rodeo. A sign-up sheet was circulated for those interested. It was noted that the girls can only talk to parents at the 3rd quarter of football games. They cannot eat, only drink allowed is water.

Ms. Singleton noted that first trip payment of \$200 is due by Friday, September 9. She also showed members the "nerd costume" for the team kick dance.
